



General Information

Please be aware that classes can fill up quickly, and previous students have priority, so do call to ensure a space.

Because instruction is individualized, adults, teens, and children are welcome to attend the same class. We take students from age 6 and up*.

Each two-hour class remains at \$40, which includes materials and personalized instruction. Due to the tremendous rise in cost of art supplies, a few special items, if used, may require an extra charge.

Registration fee is \$25 for administrative costs. This fee is waived if your total is paid in advance. Or it allows you to pay for each class on the day you attend by check or cash.

Most students attend once or twice a week; however, you may choose to attend every day for a week or two if that fits your schedule, or you can pick your own dates on the days we are open. Just multiply the number of days you wish to attend by \$40.00 to find your total cost.

Friends or members of your family are welcome to attend a single class with you for \$40.00 also, but please check to see if there is room. There is room in each class to make up any class you miss – any day, anytime there is class happening.

To register, call Daunna at 779-8749 or fill out the registration form and mail it in. You can download it from our website, and then mail it or bring it to the first class (but make sure Daunna has saved your place in the classes you want to attend). Please record your schedule as a reminder and put this on your refrigerator or bulletin board.

Make sure to wear old comfy clothes that can get paint or ink on them.
